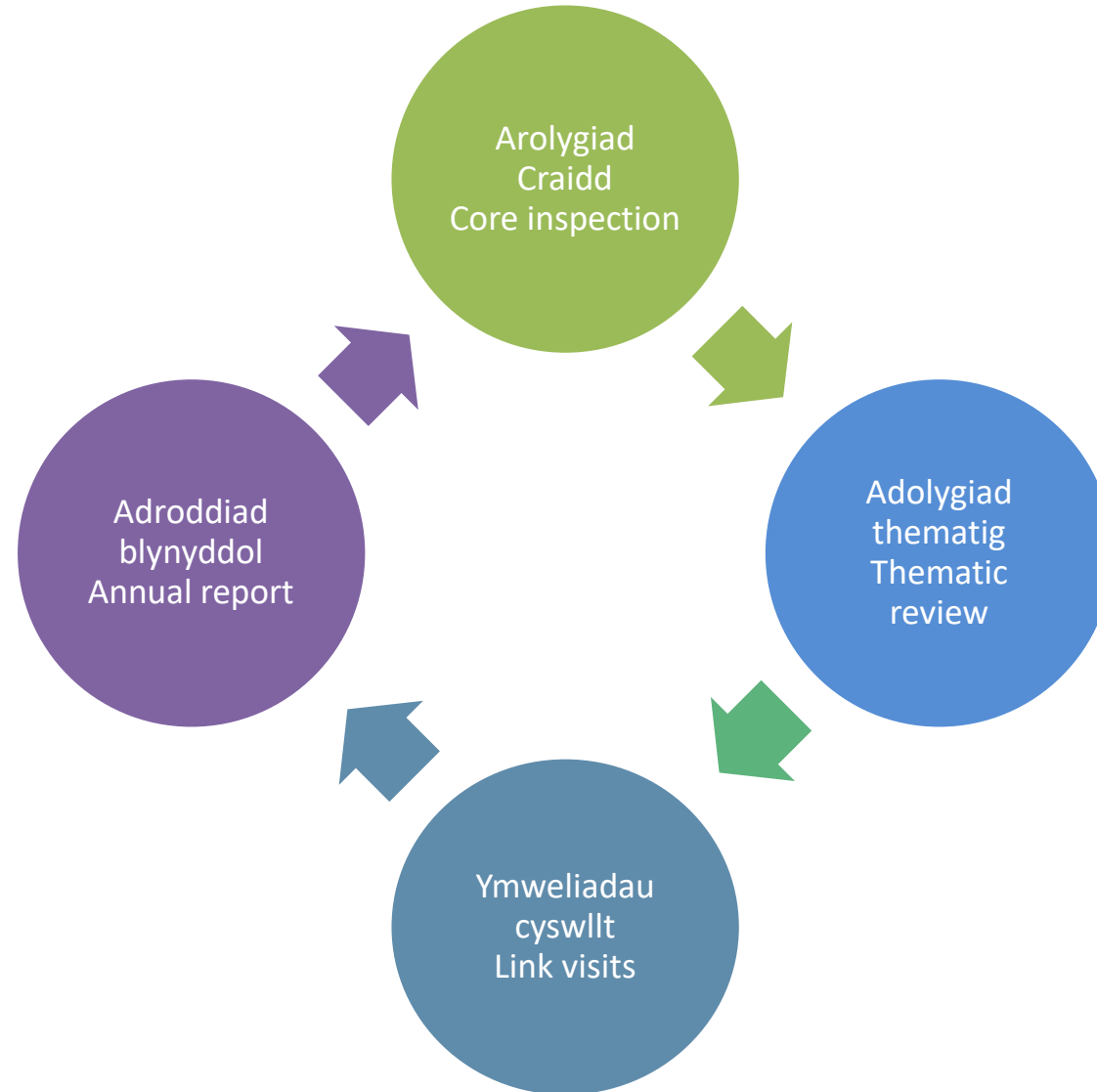

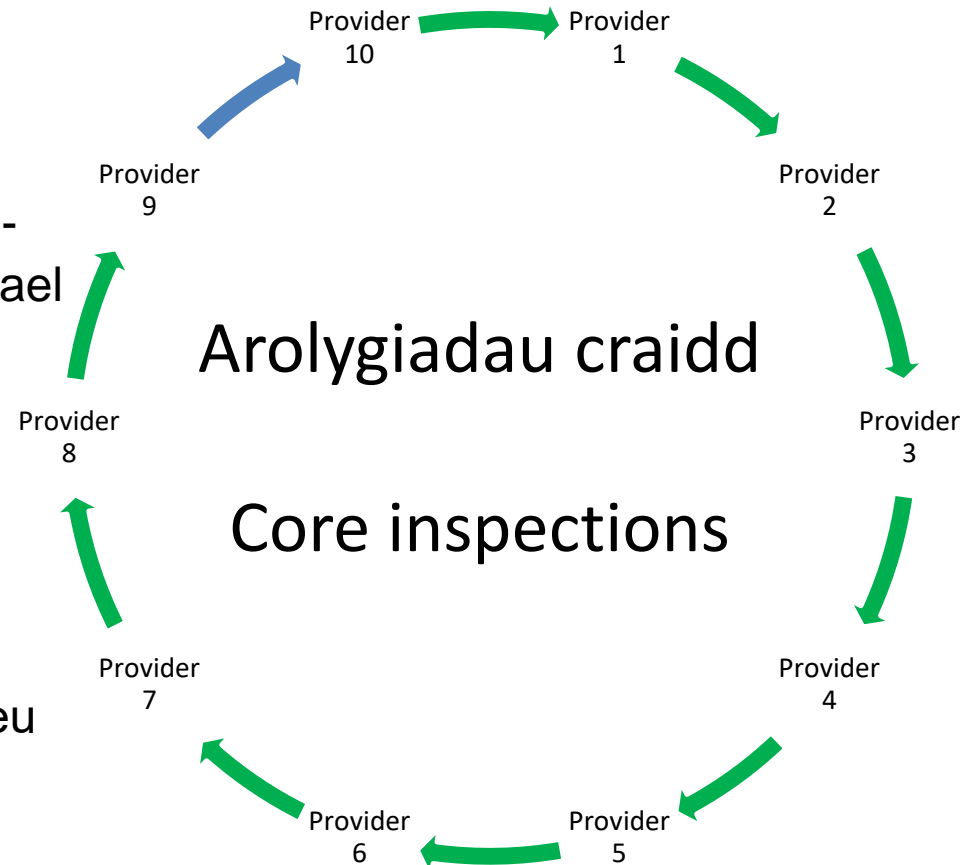

The current inspection cycle

- The current cycle ends in July 2025
- All 10 lead providers and their partner sub-contracts would have been inspected
- No overall judgements. Follow up an option
- Reports are tailored to the provider and identify the key recommendations for each provider

Work-based learning: apprenticeships

Introduction

The current Welsh Government contract for the delivery of apprenticeship programmes commenced in August 2021.

Ten training providers are commissioned contractors to deliver apprenticeship programmes commenced in August 2021. Six of the contracts are delivered by further education colleges and four by independent training providers. These 10 providers work with a range of other training providers using partnership and subcontracting arrangements to deliver training for programmes at foundation apprenticeship and higher apprenticeship levels.

Across most learning areas outcomes have improved, although they remain low in health, public services and care and hospitality and catering. Of the four inspections undertaken, one provider needed follow-up with areas for improvement causing concern.

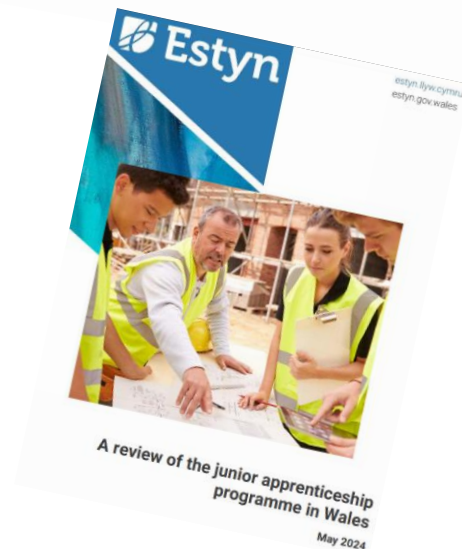
